Plugin

A “Plugin” is a term used to describe a software component that provides additional functionality, effects, or instruments that can be added to Digital Audio Workstation ([DAW](#)) software. DAWs offer tools for audio recording, editing, mixing, and mastering, and plugins are used to add various audio processing and effects to these DAWs.

Since most plugin formats typically have SDKs or APIs that are made available to other companies, many third-party developers create plugins in addition to the original ones. This means that regardless of the plugin format, there are often numerous plugins available from both the original developers and third-party manufacturers.



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
